## Description

---

**NamespaceCSS** allows users to use different CSS styles for different namespaces. This can be very useful to e.g. distinguish between different manuals or parts of your wiki.

## Usage / Features

---

It is possible to change the look of the wiki at the namespace level.

The NamespaceCss Extension makes it possible to add CSS code to all pages in `<Namespacename>`. The CSS code is written to the contents of the `<namespace name>_css` page. The extension at each page call, whether there is a "CSS page", for this in the namespace. This is then registered as StyleSheet.

Example: MediaWiki: user\_css affects all pages that are in the namespace Users
