## What is GroupManager?

Group Manager creates new groups, edit existing groups, and delete existing groups.

## Where to find the function Group Manager?

To manage groups, open the Admin tab in the left navigation bar (sidebar), then click on Group manager.

To create a group, move to the administration page via the link "WikiAdmin" (this is only

available for sysops). Then choose Group manager. The link "New"	Ð	takes you to a form

where you can enter the name of the group.

#### Assigning users to a group

This is not done via group management, but via user management, which you can find in the administration area. You can see which groups a user is a member of in the column "Groups".



## **Deleting groups**

Next to the edit button in the list, you will also see a buttons which allows you to delete group a group. If you want to delete more than one group at once please mark all groups and use the
