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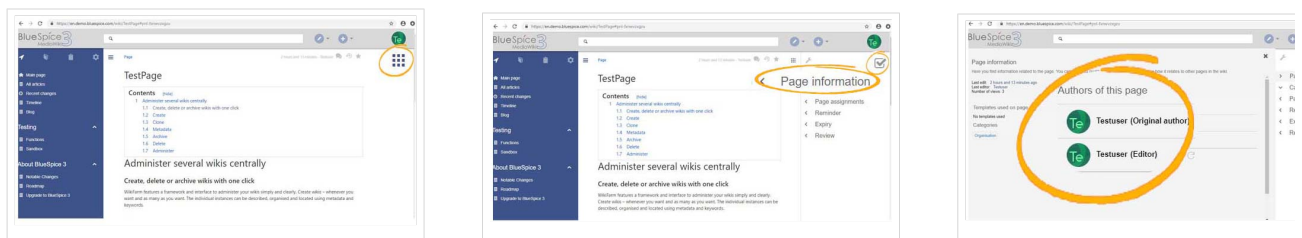
## What is Authors?

**Authors** extension displays all users who have contributed to the article.

## Where to find Authors

Authors of a page are located in the right navigation, in Page Information flyout.

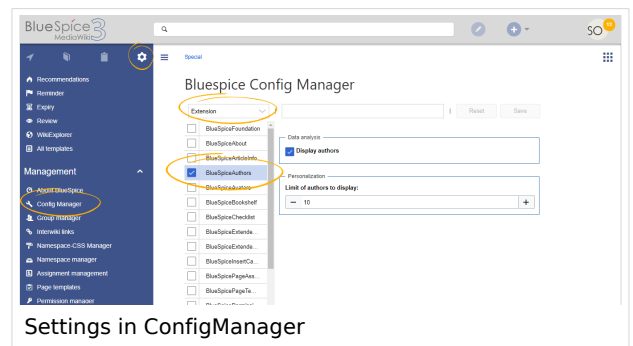
Each user in the list of authors is displayed with the role it has, original author or an editor. Original author is the user who originally created the article, while editor are all users that edited the page after its original creation.



## Settings

In **BlueSpiceConfigManager** under the section for BlueSpiceAuthors, configuration options for BlueSpiceAuthors can be found.

- Display authors - whether to display authors of a page
- Limit of authors to display - how many authors should be displayed
