Description

NamespaceCSS allows users to use different CSS styles for different namespaces. This can be very useful to e.g. distinguish between different manuals or parts of your wiki.

Usage / Features

It is possible to change the look of the wiki at the namespace level.

The NamespaceCss Extension makes it possible to add CSS code to all pages in certain namespaces. The CSS code is written to the contents of the `<namespace name>_css` page. The extension at each page call, whether there is a "CSS page", for this in the namespace. This is then registered as StyleSheet.

Example: `MediaWiki:User_css` affects all pages that are in the namespace `User`.
