Below is a set of templates which you can import into your wiki. You can upload the entire package. If you only want to use one particular template, click on the template below and download the necessary zip file for that template.

Instructions

1. [Download the package as zip file](#).
2. Unzip the archive.
3. Go to the special page `Special:Import` on your wiki (this page is only visible to users with admin rights).
 - Select the individual template file you want to upload or *AllTemplates.xml* to upload all templates.
 - Enter a *Interwiki prefix*. Since this field is required for the upload, you can simply enter *hw* (for: hallowelt).
 - Select "Template" from the *import to a namespace* select menu.

The templates are now available in your wiki and can be added using the *Insert > Template* function of Visual Editor.

About the blog

Basically, a blog is a list of comments, questions, or feedback from different users. The blog is often used chronologically, typically in the order of a public journal. A blog conversation can also occur when the contributors are better connected, recommended, listed with related articles or placed on a personal website.

The [transclude](#) function is a part of BlueSpice that lets you create a new blog entry in a page. In addition to the blog entry, there are other types of localized social entities, such as comments, discussion topics, attachments, or citations.

Contributions from all these types can be consolidated and displayed chronologically with [BlueSpiceSocial](#) in a timeline and thread view as wanted.

The blog function is ready to use on the special page [Special:Blog](#). This page is listed directly from the main navigation in every user with permission. If you can't see using the blog right entry, it's also possible to include the blog functionality on any user page. Let's get going!

Adding the blog to a page

If you want to include a new blog entry on another page of your wiki, for example your homepage, you need to insert the necessary codeblock in the source code of your page.
