What is Expiry?

Expiry marks after a certain period of time a chosen article as "obsolete". The article can be updated by editing or by confirming that the article is still up-to-date.

Expiry is the ideal basis for an archiving system. Outdated articles can be moved to an archive automatically or after being queried.

==Visibility== (modes, namespaces, views, required rights)

- The function is available to any user with the appropriate authorization
- The function is available for every article (All NRs)

Sorting

Special: Expired_Articles

- Sort by expiration date (default).
- In addition, it should be possible to sort by article, user and status.
