


What is Authors?

Authors extension displays all users who have contributed to the article. They are displayed at the bottom of the article in the form of their user images/avatars.

Where to find Authors

The main author (the one who created the article) and other contributors are shown at the bottom of each article. The main author appears first and is slightly separated from other users who have contributed to the page. If a user has been deleted there is a dummy photo with a yellow question mark instead of his or her profile picture. When the mouse hovers over the photo, the username is shown. Clicking on the picture takes you to that authors user page.
