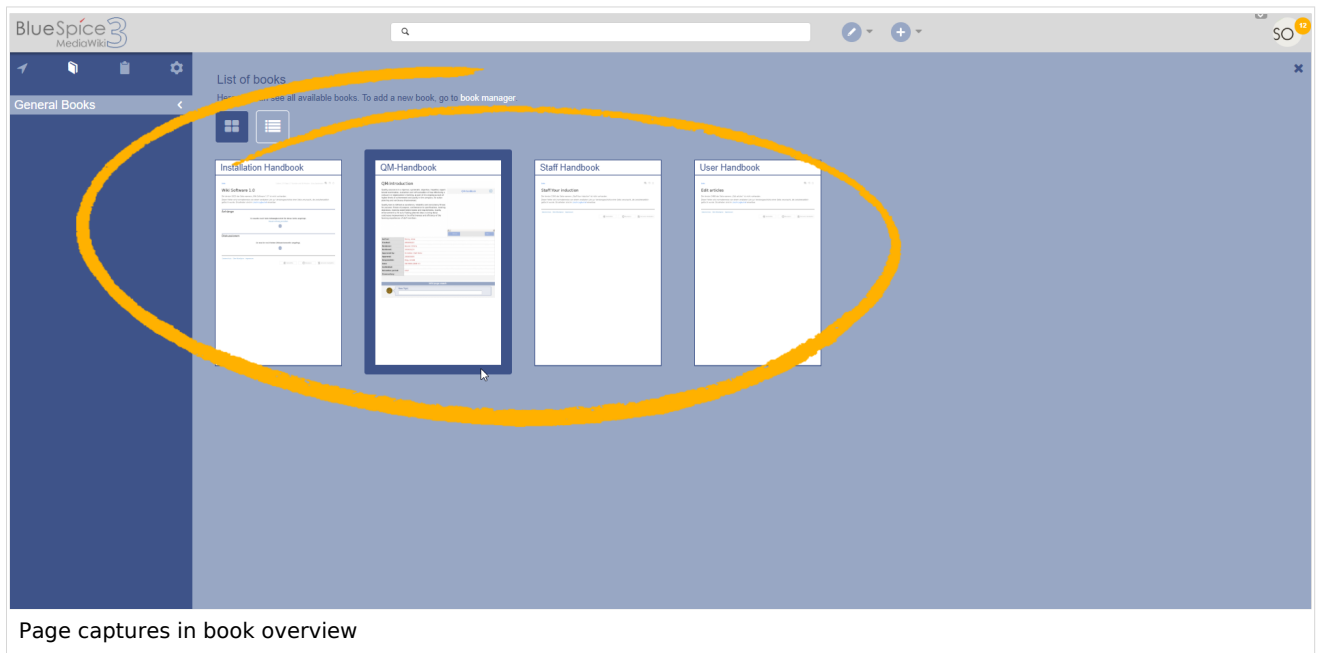

Where can you find page previews?



Thumbnail snapshots of pages are used in:

- the page *Special:SearchCenter* - to show previews of pages in search results,
- the search box, to show the top search result,
- the Recent Changes fly-out layer,
- the Book manager fly-out layer, and
- the Timeline.
