Features

BlueSpiceMultiUpload enables users to seamlessly upload multiple files to the wiki. By clicking on the *Upload file* link in the main navigation, the operating system's upload dialog opens. Multiple files can be selected.

After confirming the selection of files, a wiki upload dialog appears. Here, it is possible to add additional data such as:

- the namespace to upload to,
- category to attach to the files, and
- file descriptions.

All settings are optional.

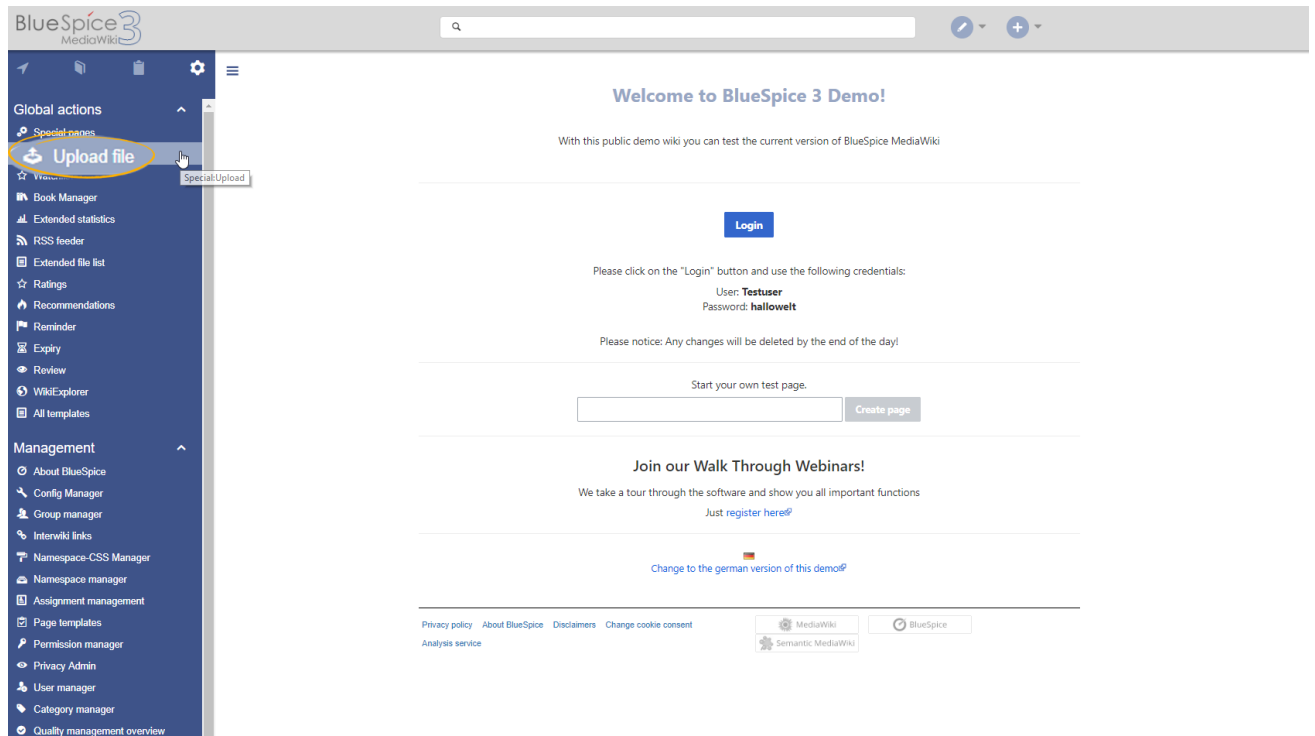
MultiUpload allows the simultaneous upload of multiple files to the wiki.

Where to find BlueSpiceMultiUpload?

If BlueSpiceMultiUpload is enabled on the wiki, it will replace the link for uploading files, which is located in the left navigation, under the *Global actions* tab.



Using BlueSpiceMultiUpload

Clicking the *Upload file* link in the left navigation opens the operating system's file manager. Multiple files can be selected.


After confirming the selection of files, a wiki upload dialog appears, in which additional data about files being uploaded can be added collectively:

- the namespace to upload to,
- the category to attach to the files,
- a description (will be the same for all files), and
- the license information
